Spirituality is a serious practice and discipline.

Sometimes we imagine that anything that is "serious" is something that requires, if not a frown, at least a respectably furrowed brow—as if we're having to work hard at this thing that is so serious.But our souls know better. Spirituality brings lightness to our being. Our spiritual practices break open fresh ground inside. Every prayer is a seed planted, a seed that will burst into surprising new life. Spirituality is about freedom, about clarity, about hope.

The same is true for humor. The very core of what makes humor, well, *humourous*, is that it **surprises** us. If we knew the punchline, we wouldn't laugh. If the friend's witticism were cliché, it wouldn't be witty. It is the structure of surprise that humor depends upon that can become an essential element in our spirituality. Jesus' parables *surprised* the original hearers . . . and if we nurture a habit of surprise in ourselves, we, too, can be surprised afresh in hearing the Word.

Humor nurtures a habit of surprise in our spiritual practice.
